Dear AMFA Members:

The NEC has determined that the reduction of members recently sustained by Locals 5 and 33 has created a situation in which steps are needed to insure that the representational interests of the remaining members continue to be met. Thus, the decision has been made to consolidate Locals 5 and 33 and to establish a trusteeship to administer the affairs of the merged Local until such time as the members of the Local are able to perform the functions of the Local.

The Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA) permits a labor organization to establish a trusteeship over a subordinate body in accordance with its constitution and bylaws for the purpose of carrying out the legitimate objectives of the labor organization. Article XVI of the AMFA Constitution authorizes the NEC to temporarily suspend a local in instances where Local is unable "to carry out the legitimate objectives of this Association." The Constitution provides that during the suspension, "the Local and the Local funds shall be under the supervision of either the National Director or the Regional Director within the region and the National Treasurer."

The trusteeship of Local 33 shall become effective on Thursday, March 1, 2007, and shall last for no more than eighteen months unless there is a clear and convincing need to continue the trusteeship beyond such time.

Two (2) members shall be appointed to oversee the day to day operation of the Local. They shall be subordinate to the National Director and the National Treasurer who shall serve as the trustees of the Local.
