POLICY STATEMENT

Caretaker Trusteeship

The AMFA Constitution contains language regarding a Local suspension as a punitive process; however, it does not contain language that applies to a Caretaker Trusteeship in accordance with the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act (LMRDA). This policy letter will serve to address the circumstances and process for invoking a Caretaker Trusteeship over a Local.

When a Local, through no wrong doing and/or charges of such, becomes unable to meet their financial obligations, the National Executive Council may invoke a Caretaker Trusteeship and take over the administration and financial functions of the Local pursuant to the provisions of the LMRDA.

The following shall apply:

- The Trusteeship order shall be sent by registered mail to such Local with a statement outlining the need for such action.
- AMFA National may appoint Trustee(s) to oversee the daily operation of the Local.
- During the Trusteeship, the Local and Local funds shall be under the supervision of either the National Director or the Regional Director within that region and the National Treasurer.
- During such period of Trusteeship, the Local shall function only in those capacities that serve the best interests of its membership as approved by the Trustee(s) and the National.

A Local placed into Trusteeship shall be subject to the provisions of Article XVI, Section 12 with the following exceptions:

- The Local and its members shall be allowed to submit Constitution Amendment Proposals.
- The Local and its members shall be allowed to send delegates to the National Convention.
- The Local and its members shall be allowed to nominate National Officers.

Note: A Local whose charter has been revoked or suspended in accordance with Article XVI, Sections 11 and 12 shall not qualify for Caretaker Trusteeship status.
