Referendum Notice

Mesaba Airlines Strike Authorization

The AMFA–Mesaba Airlines Contract Negotiation Committee has requested a referendum vote regarding authorization to allow the Association to call for a strike against Mesaba Airlines. Therefore, in accordance with Article XV, Section 7 of the Constitution, AMFA National is conducting a referendum for the membership at Mesaba Airlines.

The vote for this referendum will be conducted by mail. All active members in good standing employed at Mesaba Airlines are eligible to vote in this referendum. Ballots will be mailed by February 15, 2005 to eligible voters at the address on record with AMFA National Administration.

Any eligible member who has not received a ballot package by February 22, 2005, or any member who spoils a ballot, may request a new ballot by contacting the AMFA National Administration office at 603-527-9212. If you request another ballot, only the replacement ballot will be counted.

Mail your ballot in the pre-addressed stamped envelope in sufficient time for it to be received at PO Box 1285, Laconia NH 03247 by 10:00 AM ET on March 11, 2005. The results will be announced March 11, 2005, the day of the count.
